

Special Agent Michael Adams

Michael Adams is a Special Agent of the Immigration and Customs Enforcement, Homeland Security Investigations where he has been employed since July of 2011. Prior to becoming a Special Agent with Homeland Security Investigations, Mr. Adams was employed as a Special Agent with the United States Secret Service from June of 2000 up to his employment beginning with Homeland Security Investigations. He investigates violations of federal law relating to financial crimes, cybercrimes and the cross-border flow of people and goods. He has completed the Criminal Investigator training course offered by the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center and the Special Agent Training programs offered by Homeland Security Investigations and the United States Secret Service. He is also currently certified as a Computer Forensics Agent with Homeland Security Investigations.

Mr. Adams has investigated numerous cybercrime and digital currency cases during of his career, both with Homeland Security Investigations and the Secret Service, with an exclusive focus on cybercrime investigations beginning in 2007. His current responsibilities include investigations related to the disruption and dismantlement of transnational cybercrime organizations involved in the procurement, trafficking and use of compromised financial data, with the data primarily being obtained via network intrusion or mass data breach.
